We need to wrap-up this second section on Isaiah chapter 13-23. You will have only one week to work on this lesson. Please pace yourself accordingly.

Appendix A

First off, we are going to look at appendix A found in the back of your guide. Appendix A is for writing down everything concerning the terms "the day of the LORD," "in the day of His burning anger," "in the day," "in that day," and "at that time." Some of you have already done this, but for you who have not, this will be your opportunity to catch up. Mark these words in some special way; I marked them with a rectangle colored in with brown pencil. I would suggest that you use only your double-spaced worksheets for doing this assignment. After we finish this lesson and you are certain of your observations, then you may transfer them to your Bible if you wish. I also would suggest that you write down what will happen in "the day of the LORD," "in the day of His burning anger," "in the day," in that day," and "at that time" in the words of the text and where in the text these are found. Here are three examples:

13:6 "<u>the day of the LORD</u>" Wail for the day of the LORD is near!

13:13 <u>"in the day of His burning anger"</u>

Therefore I shall make the heavens tremble, and the earth will shake from its place at the fury of the LORD of hosts in the day of His burning anger.

14:3 <u>"in the day"</u>

And it will be in the day when the LORD gives you rest from your pain and turmoil and harsh service in which you have been enslaved, that you will take up this taunt against the king of Babylon and say....

This will take you quite some time if you write down the words of the text, but the rewards will be great, as you will be planting scripture in your mind as you do this. You also may want to add some notebook pages to Appendix A as this assignment will take up more space than you've been allotted on the page provided.

After you have finished this assignment, mark the references (for example, mark the "13:6" for Isaiah chapter 13, verse 6) in yellow, green, red, purple or blue pencil according to the following scheme:

If the terms above refer to the Millennial Kingdom, mark with yellow Tribulation Period, mark with green Possibly just prior to and into the end of the Tribulation Period, mark with red Isaiah's time and may happen again in the last days, mark with purple Isaiah Part 2: Deliverance and Comfort for the FaithfulSummary Isaiah 13-23, 36-37,39Week 6, Judgment on the NationsWrap-up of Isaiah Part 2

Appendix B

Secondly, appendix B is for writing down everything that you learned about Babylon in this second part of Isaiah. Follow the same rules as above, writing down the words of the text and also recording where the text is found.

Appendix C

Thirdly, appendix C is for writing down all that you discovered in chapters 13-23 that would be considered Messianic prophecies. I will give you one clue in finding these references. Some of the references to Messianic prophecies have a name for God revealed in the words. Follow the same rules as for Appendix A and B, writing down the "words of the text" and their references.

Appendix D

Fourthly, write down everything you have learned about the Millennium in chapters 13-23 in Appendix D.

Reread and write the major theme of each chapter at the top of the corresponding doublespaced worksheet. Some chapters have more than one theme. Now, look over all you have done with chapters 13-23. Can you read the text of chapters 13-23 and understand what you are reading?
