

We need to wrap-up this third section on Isaiah chapter 24-27.

Appendix A

First off, we are going to look at appendix A found in the back of your guide. Appendix A is for writing down everything concerning the terms “the day of the LORD,” “in the day of His burning anger,” “in the day,” “in that day,” and “at that time.” Some of you have already done this, but for you that have not, this will be your opportunity to catch up. Mark these words in some special way; I marked them with a rectangle colored in with brown pencil. I would suggest that you use only your double-spaced work sheets for doing this assignment. After we finish this lesson and you are certain of your observations, then you may transfer them to your Bible if you wish. I also would suggest that you write down what will happen in “the day of the LORD,” “in the day of His burning anger,” “in the day,” “in that day,” and “at that time” in the words of the text and where in the text they are found. Here are three examples:

24:21 “in that day”

So it will happen in that day that the LORD will punish the host of heaven, on high, and the kings of the earth, on earth.

25:9 “And it will be said in that day”

And it will be said in that day, “Behold, this is our God for whom we have waited that He might save us. This is the LORD for whom we have waited; let us rejoice and be glad in His salvation.”

26:1 “in that day”

In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: “We have a strong city; He sets up walls and ramparts for security.”

This will take you quite some time if you write down the words of the text, but the rewards will be great, as you will be planting scripture in your mind as you do this. You also may want to add some notebook pages to Appendix A as this assignment will take up more space than you’ve been allotted on the page provided.

After you have finished this assignment, mark the references (for example, mark the “24:21” for Isaiah chapter 24, verse 21) in yellow, green, red, purple or blue pencil according to the following scheme:

If the terms above refer to the
Millennial Kingdom, mark with yellow

Tribulation Period, mark with green

Possibly just prior to and into the end of the Tribulation Period, mark with red
Isaiah’s time and may happen again in the last days, mark with purple

Fulfilled in His 1st coming & will be evident when He comes again mark blue

Speaks of His 2nd coming, mark with orange.

A big hint for this section: either the timeframe is during or before the Tribulation Period or it is in the Millennial Kingdom. See Lesson 5.

Appendix C

Thirdly, appendix C is for writing down all that you discovered in chapters 24-27 that would be considered Messianic prophecies. I will give you one clue in finding these references. Some of the references to Messianic prophecies have a name for God revealed in the words. Follow the same rules as for Appendix A in writing down the “words of the text” and their references.

Appendix D

Lastly, write down every thing you have learned about the Millennium in chapters 24-27 in Appendix D. You should be able to use Appendix A to do this.

Reread Isaiah 24 through 27

Reread and write the major theme of each chapter at the top of the respective double-spaced worksheets for chapters 24 through 27. Some chapters have more than one theme. After you complete this assignment transfer your information to the Isaiah-theme-summary chart found also in the Appendix, noting the theme of Isaiah, the author, date written and segment divisions if you can.

Now, look over all you have done with chapters 24 through 27. Can you read the text of chapters 24 through 27 and understand what you are reading? Write your thoughts below:

If you have time this week, go back and read Isaiah 1 through 27. Can you understand what you are reading? If not, go back and review the text of the lessons for the chapters for which you are having difficulty.
